





Our Previous Projects in Ethiopia


Summary of previous activities

The aim of our current project is to build a school for vulnerable and forgotten children in Ethiopia. The government provided us with land approximately around 4000 Square meters for the construction of the school. The construction of the school began in 2022, but due to the challenges caused by the Global crises of COVID-19 pandemic our progress was hindered.
